Within the RURITAGE H2020 European research project and in collaboration with UCLA University of California (LA), the intensive international summer school program will equip participants with skills to build collaborative digital projects in heritage knowledge. The research training has a focus on large-scale and composite cultural natural heritage sites in rural territories with the diversity of heritage resources including archaeological sites, cultural landscapes, cultural routes, geoparks, rural landscapes.

Participants will explore how to shape and co-build information, data formats and digital tools for cultural natural heritage conceptualization, characterisation, representation and management. They will discuss the role of local communities and multiple stakeholders in determining the value of heritage and will develop projects for co-building heritage-led knowledge on local areas. Methodologies and Digital tools will be used to experience user engagement processes in European regions and beyond.
